# What to Expect



Farm Camp takes place on our 626 acres of coastal farmland, forest, and salt marsh in Freeport, Maine. Camp is based out of our historic farm house and barnyard. Campers help with barn chores, dig in our gardens, venture to the shore, and traverse our wooded trails.



## Items to Bring With You

- Extra change of clothes (pack these)
- Warm article of clothing (sweatshirt or jacket)
- Rain jacket
- Waterproof footwear
- Morning snack
- Lunch
- Afternoon snack (if your camper is signed up for After Care)
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen - We apply multiple times throughout the day!
- Hat (best sun protection)



## What to Wear

Wear clothing that you don't mind getting a little dirty and is weather appropriate. Camp runs rain or shine, and we often venture out into a light rain to explore, play, and work. Check the local weather report and send appropriate gear, such as raincoats, rain boots, and extra layers.

**Close-toed shoes are required at all times at Wolfe's Neck.**

## Handy Dandy Registration Checklist

**All registration documents are available through our online registration system, CampDoc, and must be received in our office at least 5 business days prior to the 1st day of the camp session.** Please note: a camper's registration is not complete until all appropriate paperwork is submitted.

**Registration form** (filled out online)

**Payment in full:**

- o Early bird discount: by February 15, 2018
- o Everyone else: by May 15, 2018
- o We reserve the right to cancel camp reservations not paid after May 15th.

An up-to-date copy of your child's **immunization records** OR our immunization waiver

**If your child has been prescribed an emergency medication:**

- o Self-Administration of Emergency Medication Form OR
- o Staff Administration of Emergency Medication Waiver

**If your child has been prescribed a non-emergency medication required during the camp day:**

- o Self-Administration of Non-Emergency Medication Form

We will send payment reminders to the email address with which you registered your child until full payment is received. Please check your email inbox (and spam folder) for these reminders and links to pay your balance online. Once full payment is processed and all required documents are submitted, your camper's registration is complete! Get ready for another great camp season!
