Family Tree Tea Workshop

Saturday, March 2nd, 1-2 pm

Walk through the woods to gather white pine needles and forage for other edible plants to make tea. We'll come together around our forest fire pit to make a big batch of "tree tea" and talk about the health benefits of our ingredients. Dress warmly as we'll be outside for the hour (but will have the fire for warmth!).

Make Your Own Salve


