

Parents Night Out – Liability Policy

I represent that I am the parent or legal guardian of the previously listed individual(s) and hereby consent to their use of the Wolfe's Neck Center facilities and properties. In consideration of Wolfe's Neck Center allowing, the above-named participant(s) to participate, I agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of this release. I hereby knowingly, intentionally, and voluntarily waive and release, indemnify, hold harmless, and forever discharge Wolfe's Neck Center, its staff, educators, instructors, volunteers, guests, and all others associated with Wolfe's Neck Center of and from any and all claims, demands, debts, contacts, expenses, causes of action, lawsuits, damage, and liabilities, of every kind and nature, whether known or unknown, in law or equity, that said minor(s) ever had or may have, arising from or in any way related to such minor(s)'s participation in activities in connection with Wolfe's Neck Center. I further agree that I have full and sole responsibility for the safety and well-being of the above-named participant(s) while they are using Wolfe's Neck Center facilities and/or participating in Wolfe's Neck Center programs and events. I further agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Wolfe's Neck Center, its staff, educators, instructors, volunteers' guests, and all others associated with Wolfe's Neck Center, against any loss, damage, liability, expense, costs, and/or attorneys' fees, including those brought by or on behalf, or otherwise caused by the above-named participant(s).

I furthermore authorize the program staff in the event of illness or injury to administer emergency care and to arrange for any medical transportation to the nearest healthcare facility deemed appropriate. I understand every effort will be made to contact the parent or guardian prior to any involved treatment. I grant permission to a qualified physician and /or other medical personnel to furnish medical care using the above guidelines while my child/children attend Wolfe's Neck Center's "Parents' Night Out". I also agree that my insurance carrier or I will bear the financial responsibility for any medical treatment administered under the above guidelines.

I Title 7 Maine Revised Statutes Section 252 (3)

"Under Maine law, there is no liability for injury to a participant in an agritourism activity conducted at this agritourism location if such injury results from the inherent risks of the agritourism activity. Inherent risks of agritourism activities include, among others, risks of injury inherent to land, equipment, and animals, as well as the potential for injury if you act in a negligent manner. You are assuming the risk of participating in this agritourism activity."
